Some Words about the Všehrd Association of Czech Lawyers

The Všehrd Association of Czech Lawyers is the oldest Czech lawyers' association in the Czech Republic and belongs to the oldest societies in our country at all. The first general meeting took place in a tavern in Prague on 6th May 1868. The association chose Czech Renaissance nobleman Viktorin Kornel Všehrd (1460–1520), author of Czech written treatise *Nine Books on Laws, Judiciary and Land Books of Czech Kingdom* (1499), as its patron. The association professes all patriotic and humanistic heritage of the Czech nation.

The association played an important part in professional and national conscious formation of students of law at the Czech university in Prague. It became evident during establishing and construction of democratic Czechoslovak State since 1918. The association was banned during the Nazi occupation. It was important in the process of defence of democratic values in the renewed democracy in Czechoslovakia between 1945 and 1948. The association was banned again after the Communist coup d'état in 1948 and its members were prosecuted. It was restored in 1990 and fought for restoration of democracy in Czechoslovakia as well as in the Czech Republic.

The Všehrd Association of Czech Lawyers is active in organizing of lectures, publishing legal literature and arranging meetings of teachers, students and intellectual public. It organizes great representational ball of lawyers in Prague every year. The management of the association consists exclusively of students of law.

The relief portrait of JUDr. Milada Horáková is placed in the front of the hall. She was a Czech lawyer and Member of Parliament, as a first woman she was executed in Prague by Communist regime on 27th June 1950, despite of worldwide public protest.

Exclusively persons of intellectual life who significantly contributed to enforcement of democratic values are elected honorary members by the general meeting. Only 22 people, living as well as deceased, were awarded this way until today. English philosopher Sir Roger Scruton, rector emeritus of the Charles University prof. Karel Malý, former Minister of Justice of the Czech Republic and chairman emeritus of the Czech Bar Association JUDr. Karel Čermák are among living honorary members.
